**I-91 from between New Haven and Hartford** - Take Exit 17 (heading north) or Exit 18 (heading south) onto I-691 West. Take I-691to Exit 4. Bear right at end of exit. At 2nd traffic light, take a right, and go 1 mile to Mulberry Street. Take left, and the Aqua Turf is 1/4 mile on left.
