**Directions**

**I-84 from Hartford** - Take Exit 29 (left-hand exit). At end of the exit is a light. Go straight onto Mulberry St. The Aqua Turf is on the right 1 mile.  
**I-84 from Waterbury** - Take Exit 28. Right off exit. Go to 2nd underpass and take left at carwash. Go to 1st stop sign, take right onto Mulberry St. The Aqua Turf is 1/2 mile on right.  
**I-91 from between New Haven and Hartford** - Take Exit 17 (heading north) or Exit 18 (heading south) onto I-691 West. Take I-691 to Exit 4. Bear right at end of exit. At 2nd traffic light, take a right, and go 1 mile to Mulberry Street. Take left, and the Aqua Turf is 1/4 mile on left.
